<b>Online Application</b>	From the Christ Academy website select <b>Apply Now</b> and <b>Create an Account</b> , then log in to your account and <b>Create a New Student Application</b> . Within the online application, you will be asked to upload report cards and standardized testing reports, if any, and you will be asked to enter names and email addresses from your child's current school or daycare. The \$75 non-refundable application fee is due when the application is submitted.

When you come for your scheduled screening, Junior High applicants will be asked to write a paragraph of at least 5 sentences in 30 minutes or less on the following prompt about leadership; Senior High applicants will be asked to write an essay of 300-500 words in 30 minutes or less on the following prompt about leadership.

Leadership is not limited to officers in student groups. Leadership can also be demonstrated through such things as standing firm on your convictions, mentoring other students, and participation in team sports or other activities.
